event.
☐ Treat opposing coaches, participants, and spectators with respect.
☐ Coach in a positive manner and do not use derogatory comments or
abusive language.
☐ Win with humility and lose with dignity.
☐ Treat every athlete fairly, justly, impartially, intelligently, and with
sensitivity.
☐ Always place the well-being, health, and safety of swimmers above all
other considerations, including developing performance.
☐ Continue to seek and maintain their own professional development in
all areas in relation to coaching and teaching children.
☐ Always maintain a professional separation between coach and athlete.
Any complaints of a coach violating this code of conduct will be brought to the attention of his, her supervisor and/or the club's hoard of director.
